Model A Ford club of Colorado Hubley Guidelines Rules*

The following Hubley Guidelines/Rules are presented here to let you prepare your Hubley Car/Truck for our event at Beaver Run Resort in Breckenridge, CO. Please note that there are only 2 classes that will compete on Tuesday evening June 13, 2023.

The Track:

- Two lanes wide
- Forty feet long.
- Manual car "launching"
- Pillow or soft object at end of the track

The Cars:

- The cars must be metal 1:20 scale models made by Hubley, Gabriel, and Scale Model. Any of the seven Model "A" body styles may be used: Sedan, Station Wagon, Coupe, Roadster, Roadster Pickup, Victoria, and Phaeton.
- Cars must be stock including the original tires, wheels, and axle screws. No modifications allowed. Steering may be secured or loose at makers choice.
- Weight of each car can be no more than 1 pound, 5 ounces (station wagon weight). A small amount of leeway will be allowed due to the differences of scales. Weights added to lighter cars must be secured, not loose in car.
- A dry lubricant (graphite for example) is allowed at owners' choice.

The Classes:

Class 1: 3-17 year olds

Class 2: 18 and over

Note:

A Hubley can only race in one class and by only one entrant.

The Race:

After the cars are checked in, all handling and racing of the cars is done by race personnel.

At the time their cars are being raced, the competitors may be called up to the track.

Cars from each class will be pitted against each other in random order to determine Champion, 2nd, and 3rd place.

In the final event, the two classes Champions **may** race to determine the overall winner.
