Starting in Durango, our Model A's will travel north to Silverton, then continue along the legendary Million Dollar Highway toward Ouray.

This spectacular stretch through the San Juan Mountains delivers dramatic cliffs, alpine switchbacks, and unforgettable high-country views – one of the most scenic drives in North America.

## Can't-Miss Stops

Ouray - Historic mining town and lunch stop

Silverton – Historic mining town and lunch stop.

Red Mountain Pass Overlook – High elevation panoramic views.

Box Canyon Falls – A powerful 285-foot waterfall crashing through a narrow canyon.  
Switzerland of America Lookout - Panoramic views of the jagged peaks and snow-capped summits that resemble the iconic landscapes of Switzerland.

## What to Expect

- Approximately 140-150 miles total driving
- Estimated driving time: 3.5 to 4 hours total
- Mountain scenery with elevation changes
  - Optional walking and exploration
- Outstanding photography opportunities

# Wolf Creek Pass Tour



## Climb Above The Clouds

Departing from Durango, we head east through scenic valleys before ascending over Wolf Creek Pass at more than 10,800 feet. This route offers steady grades, expansive summit views, forested landscapes, and classic Rocky Mountain touring at a comfortable pace.

## Can't-Miss Stops

- Wolf Creek Pass Summit – Classic photo opportunities.
- Treasure Falls – Beautiful roadside waterfall with a short walking trail.
- Chimney Rock National Monument – Ancient Puebloan ceremonial site with dramatic views.
- Pagosa Springs – Charming lunch stop known for natural hot springs.

## What to Expect

- Approximately 160-175 miles total driving
- Estimated driving time: 4 to 4.5 hours total
- Mountain scenery with elevation changes
  - Optional walking and exploration
- Outstanding photography opportunities
